Langrish British Championship Round 7

Gidday all it has been a load of traveling this past month so haven't had much time to write a race report. Well Jason and I had a phew weeks together doing our own training and riding. As the other boys were getting ready for the junior worlds down in Bulgaria. Since Hamish was doing that it was just going to be me racing the British Champs. I had a good two weeks leading up to it with doing one week in Belgium and one week in England. For me it's about more bike time the better and that's what I did with loads of motos and technique practise.

Langrish time I looked at the track throughout the week on the internet and it seemed to be my type of track hard pack and fast. As we got to the event on Saturday there was a vintage race going on so was good to see how the track formed and Also to see them old bikes battle around there I'm glad I don't race on those things. Sunday was racing time as I went out for practise and qualifying the track was great I got phew good laps in and changed the suspension a bit and came out with 14th fastest. This gave me a good gate pick for the first race and got me a solid top 10 start. I was running in 12th for most of the race until last couple of laps had trouble getting through the lappers and dropped back to 14th to finish the race. Second race had an even better start with being in 7th for the first couple of laps. But running that speed I was trying to hard and wasn't flowing at all and dropped back to 17th. Before the last race Jason ran through some things with me that were going wrong and I walked the whole track finding lines and got fired up for the last race. I knew if I get another good start I can run that top 10 speed. But the start didn't happen for me coming around the corner in the 20s. But got to work early and in half a lap my lines were on point and was in 10th for five minutes then moved into 9th place and remained there for the rest of the race. It was great way to end my day and a huge improvement from the last British round. I finished up in 13th overall two points off tenth place so was tight racing I was happy with the result.

I have now been called for the Dutch GP so well excited !!
