The flag flew and the 2014 season was underway. I was third round turn one but moved into the lead before entering the woods. Early in the second to last lap, I clipped something in a deep rut that bent my brake lever back to my foot peg. I stopped and kicked it out so the wheel would roll. I stopped again further down the track when I saw some help (thanks Todd )to lay the boot into it cause it was so far bent I would stand on the brake when I stood one the pegs. By this time Charlie was gone and now I just need to hold onto second. The brake kept snagging in ruts and bending out again so I just kept kicking it in when I could and made it to the line.
