Race Report: GNCC Round 8 Snow Shoe, WV Rider: Paul Whibley Team: AmPro Yamaha Bike: Yamaha YZ450 F Result: 3<sup>rd</sup> XC1



Riders were seeded into rows of five and lined the road atop of Snow Shoe Mountain ready for the start of the eighth round of the GNCCs. A live engine and each row would be released at 10 second intervals, something a little different at Snow Shoe since there is limited space at the top of the mountain.

I took the start and led the way down the ski slope until Kailub Russell passed me in a brave move and nearly paid the price, hitting a rain bar, 4<sup>th</sup> gear, and riding the front wheel for ages, only just saving it. I followed him into the woods and through some massive mud holes that looked like a bomb had gone off after the quads and morning races had been through. I managed to open up a small gap. I was now up to third and made it to the finish to salvage some good points from a tough day at the office.
